

SUBMISSION TO THE ENNIS MUNICIPAL DISTRICT, 3A PLAN

AS ATTACHED TO THE COUNTY DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2023 - 2029

- On the enclosed map of current Ennis/Environs Plans (2014 2023), our property (LDR70) is zoned (Lower Density Residential).
- With this submission, we now apply for a re-zoning of our property to Full Residential Status based on the following:
 - With the demise of the Roche plant in Clarecastle and the SEVESO Directive, that limited housing construction in the area, we now feel optimistic that our property would be suitable for full residential development.
 - Comprising of 4.4 acres, the property shares an elevated location with the Clarehill housing estate and the adjacent residential development of Beechwood.
 - The property is also linked to all essential services including the public sewage system.
 - Due to it's elevated situation there is no flood risk in any area of the site.
 - I have also enclosed a drawing which was professionally prepared for a full residential development on our property comprising of 29 houses and 12 apartments. Apart from the main entrance from the Lissane Road, there are other potential entrances/exits indicated with arrows.
 - With full residential status, this property would prompt a greater interest from developers who have shown a previous interest.

For 20 years plus we have been unsuccessful in obtaining full residential status in previous plans and applications, consequently we now appeal to you to grant us Full Residential Status in this new plan.
