Re: Submission to the Clare County Development Plan 2023-2029

Dear Sir/Madam,

TFI Local Link Limerick Clare welcomes the draft stage consultation on the Clare County Development Plan 2023-2029. We submit the following observations for the Councils consideration which may inform the preparation of the County Development Plan. We are also available for any further consultation if required.

Many thanks for taking on board our points in our pre-draft submission dated 16<sup>th</sup> November 2020.

Could all references to 'Local Link' in the document be replaced with 'TFI Local Link Limerick Clare'. The company now comes under the banner of Transport for Ireland (TFI), the brand name for all public transport in Ireland.

### ***Ennis Municipal District Volume 3a***

We support the proposal put forward for the Friar's Walk Transformational Site (TS4). In particular, a new bus shelter to promote and provide for public transport infrastructure is most welcome.

We support the delivery of a town bus service for Ennis. We will work closely with Clare County Council to support and improvements to public transport services and infrastructure in the settlement area including the delivery of an Ennis town bus service.

### ***Barefield Village p.104***

The following is a quote from the Barefield village written statement

'The village is not currently served by public transport, however securing a bus service will be encouraged in any future active and sustainable travel plans'

TFI Local Link Limerick Clare as a public transport operator does serve Barefield village.

Our C13 service operates every Saturday serving Barefield village twice a day to Ennis, Crusheen, Ballyalla Lake and Ballinruan.

### ***Shannon Municipal District Volume 3b***

#### *Sixmilebridge P.14*

To include: TFI Local Link Limerick Clare serves Sixmilebridge on a Thursday weekly through the C10 service given access to Shannon.

#### *Newmarket on Fergus P. 80*

To include: TFI Local Link Limerick Clare serves Newmarket on Fergus through the C4 service. This service runs Monday-Friday and links to Ennis and Shannon and runs twice a day.

### ***Killaloe Municipal District Volume 3c***

#### *Scarriff/Tuamgraney P. 11*

Amend to the following:

Scarriff/Tuamgraney is serviced by both the TFI Local Link Limerick Clare C1, C2 & C10 Services to Ennis, Killaloe and Shannon and Bus Eireann Service to Limerick.

#### *Killaloe P.28*

Amend to the following:

The Killaloe is serviced by public transport with a regular Bus Eireann Service to Limerick and a TFI Local Link Limerick Clare C2 service from Scarriff to Killaloe, Monday to Friday.

#### *Whitegate P. 73*

*Amend to the following:*

Bus Eireann and TFI Local Link Limerick Clare provide a valuable bus service to Whitegate. This service provides a valuable alternative to the private car for local residents and encourages a modal shift to a more sustainable transport option. The TFI Local Link routes C2 Monday-Friday's and C1 on Saturday's serve Whitegate.

#### *Kilmurry P.116*

'Local Link provides a convenient and valuable bus transport service with a drop off/collection point in the village.'

TFI Local Link Limerick Clare don't currently service Kilmurry.

*Tulla P. 37*

Amend to the following:

Transport, Active Travel and Connectivity

Bus Eireann provides two services which stop in Tulla, a Limerick- Tulla- Scariff-Whitegate route and Scariff-Flagmount-Feakle- Tulla- Ennis route. TFI Local Link Limerick Clare provides three services which stop in Tulla, the C1 Feakle-Scariff-Tulla-Ennis route and the C4 Feakle-Ennis route and the C11 Feakle-Flagmount-Tulla-Ennis route. These are valuable bus services for the town which provides an alternative to the private car and aids and encourages a modal shift towards more sustainable modes of transport.

*Crusheen P. 44*

Amend to the following:

Transport, Active Travel and Connectivity

Bus Eireann provides an hourly service to/from Crusheen on the Galway to Limerick route. This is a valuable bus service for the village which provides an alternative to the private car. TFI Local Link Limerick Clare provides a twice a day Saturday service through its C13 connecting to Barefield, Ballyalla and Ennis.

*Feakle P. 49*

Transport, Active Travel and Connectivity

Feakle is served by Clare Bus with a three times a day weekday service from Feakle to Ennis. This service provides a valuable alternative to the private car and encourages a modal shift to a more sustainable transport option.'

Point of clarification: TFI Local Link Limerick Clare currently provide this service.

Amend to the following:

Transport, Active Travel and Connectivity

Feakle is served by TFI Local Link Limerick Clare by the following routes; C1 Feakle-Scariff-Tulla-Ennis Monday to Friday, C4 Feakle-Ennis Monday to Friday, C7 Feakle-Gort Friday's, C9 Feakle-Ennis Thursday's and C11 Feakle-Ennis on a Saturday. These services provide a valuable alternative to the private car and encourages a modal shift to a more sustainable transport option.

#### *Kilkishen P.54*

##### ‘Transport, Active Travel and Connectivity

Kilkishen is served by Clare Bus with a weekday service on the Feakle to Ennis route however services in the village are not as frequent as other villages along the route. The village is also serviced by Bus Eireann on the Limerick to Tulla route via Sixmilebridge. These services provide a valuable alternative to the private car and encourages a modal shift to a more sustainable transport option.’

Point of clarification: TFI Local Link Limerick Clare currently provide this service.

Amend to the following:

##### Transport, Active Travel and Connectivity

Kilkishen is served by three TFI Local Link Limerick Clare services. The C1 runs from Feakle to Ennis via Scariff and Tulla Monday to Saturday. The C3 runs from Ennis to Feakle via Kilkishen Monday to Friday and the C9 Feakle-Kilkishen-Quin-Ennis runs every Thursday. The village is also serviced by Bus Eireann on the Limerick to Tulla route via Sixmilebridge. These services provide a valuable alternative to the private car and encourages a modal shift to a more sustainable transport option.

#### *Mountshannon P.60*

Amend to the following:

##### Transport, Active Travel and Connectivity

Bus Eireann provides a Saturday Service from Limerick to Mountshannon and the expansion of the bus service would greatly support the tourism product in the area and would provide a valuable alternative to the private car for local residents, encouraging a modal shift to a more sustainable transport option.

TFI Local Link Limerick Clare provide two services from Mountshannon, the C1 Scariff-Whitegate on Saturdays and the C2 Scariff-Whitegate Monday to Friday’s.

#### *Quin P.67*

##### ‘Transport, Active Travel and Connectivity

Quin is served by Clare Bus with a weekday service on the Feakle to Ennis route. This service provides a valuable alternative to the private car for local residents and encourages a modal shift to a more sustainable transport option.’

Point of clarification: TFI Local Link Limerick Clare currently provide this service.

Amend to the following:

Quin is served by TFI Local Link Limerick Clare with three services. These include the C1 Scariff to Ennis on a Saturday, the C3 Ennis to O’Callaghan’s Mills Monday to Friday and the C9 Feakle-Kilkishen-Quin-Ennis on Thursday’s.

*Clooney P.97*

'Location and Context

Clooney comprises a small linear group of houses based around a church, petrol station and shop. The Clare Bus provides a convenient and valuable transport service with a drop off/collection point at the church in the village'

Amend to the following:

Clooney comprises a small linear group of houses based around a church, petrol station and shop. TFI Local Link Limerick Clare provides a convenient and valuable transport service with a drop off/collection point at the church in the village. The C1 Feakle to Ennis via Scariff and Tulla service stops in Clooney six times a day Monday to Friday and twice a day on a Friday. The C4 Feakle to Ennis stops in Clooney twice a day Monday to Friday. The C11 Feakle-Flagmount-Tulla-Ennis stops in Clooney twice a day every Saturday.

*O'Callaghan's Mills P. 129*

'Clare Bus provides a convenient and valuable transport service in East Clare, while O'Callaghan's Mills is not on the main route, stops in the village can be requested as needed as part of this service.'

Amend to the following:

'TFI Local Link Limerick Clare provide a C2 Scariff-Killaloe-Scariff service. It provides a convenient and valuable transport service in East Clare. The stop is the Church in O'Callaghan's Mills and it stops twice a day Monday to Friday. The C1 Feakle to Ennis via Scariff and Tulla service stops twice a day Monday to Friday and three times on a Saturday. The C9 service Feakle-Kilkishen-Quin-Ennis stops in O'Callaghan's Mills once a day.

*Ballinruan P.80*

There is no mention of the transport TFI Local Link Limerick Clare provide in Ballinruan.

The C13 Ennis-Ballyalla-Barefield-Crusheen-Ennis Saturday service can stop in Ballinruan on a demand responsive basis.

*Bodyke P. 84*

There is no mention of the transport TFI Local Link Limerick Clare provide in Bodyke.

The TFI Local Link Limerick Clare C1 Feakle to Ennis via Scariff and Tulla stops at Bodyke church six times a day Monday to Friday and four times on Saturdays. The C2 Scariff- O'Callaghan's Mills-Scariff service stops in Bodyke twice a day Monday to Friday. The C10 Scariff- Shannon stops in Bodyke twice on Thursdays.

*Broadford P.87*

There is no mention of the transport TFI Local Link Limerick Clare provide in Broadford.

The TFI Local Link Limerick Clare C10 Scariff-Sixmilebridge-Shannon stops in Broadford twice on Thursdays.

*Caher P. 93*

There is no mention of the transport TFI Local Link Limerick Clare provide in Caher.

The TFI Local Link Limerick Clare C10 Scariff-Flagmount-Scariff stops in Caher twice on Thursdays. The C11 Feakle-Flagmount-Tulla-Ennis stops in Caher twice on Saturdays. The C7 Flagmount-Derrybrien-Gort service stops twice on Fridays.

*Flagmount P.101*

There is no mention of the transport TFI Local Link Limerick Clare provide in Flagmount.

The TFI Local Link Limerick Clare C10 Scariff-Flagmount-Scariff stops in Flagmount twice on Thursdays. The C11 Feakle-Flagmount-Tulla-Ennis stops in Flagmount twice on Saturdays. The C7 Flagmount-Derrybrien-Gort service stops twice on Fridays.

*Killanena P.112*

There is no mention of the transport TFI Local Link Limerick Clare provide in Killanena.

The TFI Local Link Limerick Clare C10 Scariff-Flagmount-Scariff stops in Killanena twice on Thursdays. The C7 Flagmount-Derrybrien-Gort service stops twice on Fridays.

*Ogonnelloe P.133*

There is no mention of the transport TFI Local Link Limerick Clare provide in Ogonnelloe.

The TFI Local Link Limerick Clare C2 Scariff-Killaloe-Scariff stops at the National School twice a day Monday to Friday.

***West Clare Municipal District Volume 3d***
