Under the current Development Plan for Athlunkard this is marked zoned as Open Space (OS3) on map below and tl

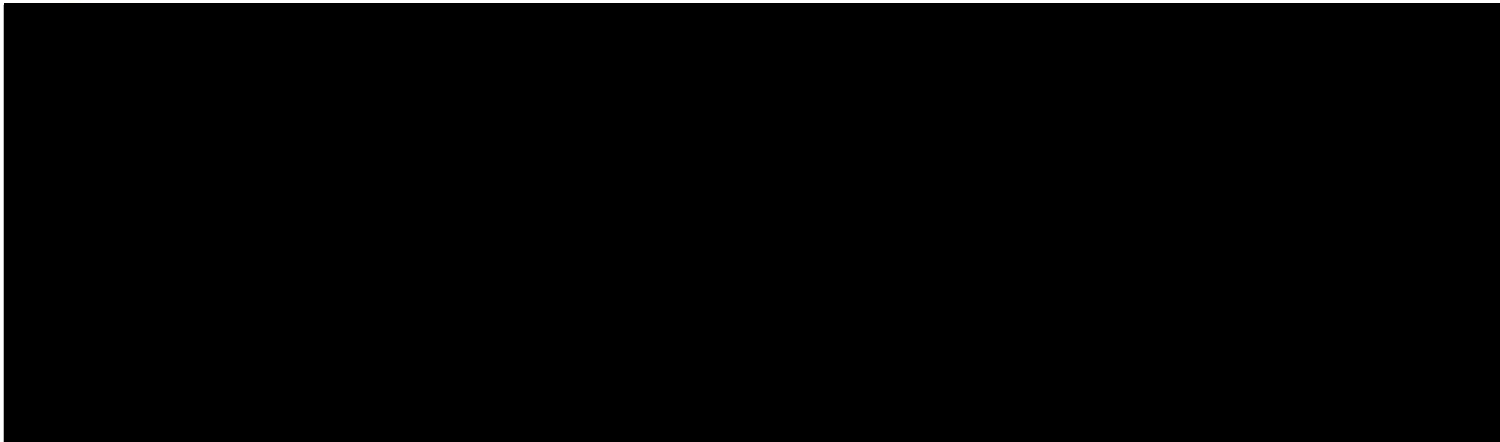
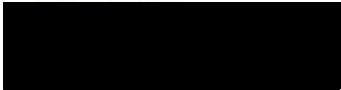
